On October 24, 2018, Fulton County Board of Health adopted the Georgia Department of Public Health Pool Rules and Regulations for Public Swimming Pools, Spas, and Recreational Water Parks.

Effective October 24, 2018:

Existing pools will be inspected in compliance with the CHAPTER 511-3-5 "POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR PUBLIC SWIMMING POOLS, SPAS, AND RECREATIONAL WATER PARKS."

Effective July 1, 2019:

New pools must be constructed in compliance with the CHAPTER 511-3-5 "POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR PUBLIC SWIMMING POOLS, SPAS, AND RECREATIONAL WATER PARKS."
