ARTICLE XXIII

OCCUPANCY CERTIFICATE

23.1 <u>CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY</u>.

A Certificate of Occupancy, indicating that a building, lot and use comply with the Building code and this Zoning Resolution is required under provisions of the Fulton County Building Code. Said Certificate of Occupancy shall be posted on site where it is visible for inspection for a period of 30 days from the date of issuance. (Amended 09/05/01)

Any owner, authorized agent, or contractor who desires to change the use of a building or structure shall first make application to the building official, obtain the required permits, and obtain a Certificate of Occupancy prior to occupying said structure. (Added 04/03/02)
