**DATE OF REPORT:** 4.30.2024

**PREPARATION FOR ELECTION / WORK SUMMARY:**

For the month of April, we were conducting training, and preparing for the first day of Early Voting which began on April 29<sup>th</sup>. To date, it has been a slow turn out, but our main goal is continuing support for the 36 AV locations in the field. We developed and implemented real-time EV Location monitoring and review system, including hourly reconciliation of all our locations and putting corrective actions in place if any issues develop we are able to address them immediately. This allows us to rapidly identify errors, weaknesses or provide answer to time sensitive questions as needed.

And so far, the system has been going well and no substantial issue have arisen.

## FINANCE

**DATE OF REPORT:** 04/26/2024

**PREPARATION FOR ELECTION / WORK SUMMARY:**

The Fulton County Board of Commissioners (BOC) approved 2024 Elections budget is funding for the 1<sup>st</sup> four election cycles. The Finance department's plan is to fund the December 2024 General run-off election, if needed, from the overall Fulton County underruns.

The Financial Systems manager has managed the two temporary staffing agencies to onboard temporary employees and to request billing reports for the temporary staff. We continue to meet with the temporary staffing agencies to coordinate their recruiting efforts to fill open temporary positions.

The remaining balances of the 2023 November and December municipal elections budget were rolled over into 2024 to fund the rest of the 2023 municipal election expenses. We are tracking the 2023 budget to actual costs analysis to ensure we adhere to the municipal election budget. We are continuing to process vendor invoices received for the 2023 municipal elections. We are following up with vendors who have not submitted their 2023 invoices to us.

### PREPARATION FOR ELECTION / WORK SUMMARY:

**May 21<sup>st</sup> General Primary Election:** The Information Systems staff begin preparation for the May 21<sup>st</sup> General Primary Election. The main items in preparation are listed below.

- **Logic & Accuracy Testing** – Logic & Accuracy Testing begin on April 8<sup>th</sup> and will continue through May 16<sup>th</sup>. The Information Systems staff started and continue to conduct Logic & Accuracy Testing and program all equipment for Election Day. The Information Systems staff will conduct Logic & Accuracy testing and complete updates on all Poll Pads used at Election Day sites and have these Poll Pads completed by May 19<sup>th</sup>.
- **Technical Support** – The Information Systems staff will provide technical support for Advance Voting which starts on April 29<sup>th</sup> and ends on May 17<sup>th</sup>. Systems Specialists will also provide technical support for all Election Day sites on Election Day, May 21<sup>st</sup>.
- **Sunday Pick Up** – Provide Poll Pads, seals, precinct supply bags, and precinct binders to the Poll Manager for Election Day on Sunday, May 19<sup>th</sup>.
- **Election Night** – Closing out advance voting tabulators. Uploading memory cards from each Advanced Voting and Election Day precinct and tabulate. Display results and send reports to the SOS.
- **Post-Election** – Receive in all voting equipment that was used in the General Primary Election. Conduct final tabulation and prepare reports for certification.

## VOTER EDUCATION

**DATE OF REPORT:** April 30, 2024

**PREPARATION FOR ELECTION / WORK SUMMARY:**

In April, the Voter Education and Outreach team focused on high schools and colleges within the county to ensure students had voter education opportunities prior to graduation. The VEO team continued collaborating with the Fulton County Libraries and the High Museum of Art to promote the upcoming Primary election. The VEO manager continues to conduct deputy registrar training for citizens who want to host voter registration drives. The VEO team will continue outreach to senior centers to ensure they know how to vote and provide identification card services if needed.

The Voter Education and Outreach Manager communicated to the Fulton County Delegation members and the Mayor, City Council, and City clerks across all cities with updated election collateral in preparation for the May 21<sup>st</sup> election. The manager is also obtaining a list of the Fulton County and APS principals so that she can send the election collateral to them.

The VEO Manager continues to meet with the external affairs team to discuss collateral for the 2024 election cycle and continues to work to coordinate any request for interviews. The VEO manager is also discussing different avenues to promote the upcoming election and has started creating PSAs that will be posted on the county's social media channels for promotion.

The VEO manager attended The National Association of Election Officials special workshop in Portland, OR, and participated in CERA Class 4, continuing to work on certification. The VEO manager will begin planning the upcoming civic holidays to ensure they are promoted and the public is aware.

The VEO team will continue to contact schools, communities, non-profit organizations, and government officials regarding scheduling future events. We are developing ongoing outreach opportunities with various groups to strengthen our impact on the community.
